### EC/AEA/ACI initiative to help passengers understand new security rules



AEA, along with the airports' association ACI Europe and the European Commission, have developed a package of communication materials aiming to explain to passengers how they will be affected by the new EU security rules on liquids which will come into force on 6 November.

A leaflet and a poster will explain, both visually and in simple language, what passengers can expect when going through security checkpoints. By making sure that our passengers have made the appropriate preparations, we hope that waiting times will be reduced to a minimum.

This joint EC-AEA-ACI initiative aims to communicate the new measures to passengers in a consistent manner throughout Europe, by both airlines and airports. This communication material will be used on airports and airlines' websites, as posters in airport terminals, as leaflets available at check-in counters, and indeed in any way that ensures maximum awareness of these new rules.
